LLM	 ARGUCOM Entrance Test (AET) to be conducted by the School of Public Policy and Law to provisionally select candidates for admission into the 2 years LL.M Programme (date to be notified later). The entrance will carry 150 marks. It will contain 50 multiple choice questions carrying 2 marks each totalling 100 marks. The paper will contain questions on Constitutional law, Administrative law, Company law, Law of Contract, Environmental law, IPR and Jurisprudence. Students will have to write an essay on a current legal topic which shall carry 30 marks. Students will have to write the essay within the space provided in the booklet. No extra sheet shall be provided to the candidates. Viva – voce will contain 20 marks. The admission committee thereafter will prepare a merit list of provisionally selected candidates which shall be displayed in the university notice board and website.

> Scholarship to students under three (3) categories:
