Relaxation of 5% of the minimum percentage will be applicable to the reserved categories as per Govt. of India rules.

<p>PhD(Artificial Intelligence/Bioinformatics/Data Mining/DNA Computing)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Master's degree or a professional degree in the relevant subjects or declared equivalent to the Master's degree with at least 55%marks in aggregate (or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale/ an equivalent grade in a point scale. • Students in the final semester/trimester of respective postgraduate Programmes' are also eligible to apply for the PhD Programme. Such candidates upon selection would be admitted provisionally and have to produce proof of having passed the qualifying examination within Six months of admission. • Candidates in service in Govt./Private/PSUs etc. must submit a "No Objection Certificate" from competent authority along with the application form for Ph.D. • A relaxation of 5% of marks may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-abled or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The same is permissible based only on the qualifying marks without

Procedure for Admission

MBA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Candidates securing 60% marks in UG Programmes are eligible directly for appearing in GD & PI • Candidates not securing 60% mark, who aspire for admission into MBA programme should have CAT/ MAT/ XAT/ ATMA/CMAT/NMAT or ARGUCOM Entrance Test (AET) to be conducted by the School of Entrepreneurship & Management. (Dates to be notified later). • AET shall comprise of 100 marks with 25 questions each from English Language, General Knowledge, Reasoning and Quantitative Aptitude. • On the basis of the scores of above-mentioned tests, the candidates short listed will be called for Group Discussion and Personal Interview. • Candidates selected upon successful performance shall be eligible for admission which shall be notified.

<p>M.Com</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Candidates securing 50% marks in UG program are eligible directly for admission on merit basis. • Candidates not securing 50% marks, who aspire for admission into M.Com program, should appear for the Personal Interview organized by the University. • On the basis of the scores of the above-mentioned test (scores to be decided by the School of Entrepreneurship & Management), the candidates short listed will be called for Personal Interview.
<p>MCA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ARGUCOM Entrance Test (AET) to be conducted by the School of Innovation & Technology. (Dates to be notified later). • AET will carry 100 marks consists of four sections as : General English (25 marks), Numerical Aptitude (25 marks), Logical Reasoning (25 marks) & General Awareness (25 marks) • On the basis of the scores of above-mentioned tests, the selected candidates shall be eligible for admission which shall be notified through website and email.
<p>LLM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ARGUCOM Entrance Test (AET) to be conducted by the School of Public Policy and Law to provisionally select candidates for admission into the 2 years LLM Programme (date to be notified later). • The entrance will carry 150 marks. It will contain 50 multiple choice questions carrying 2 marks each totalling 100 marks. The paper will contain questions on Constitutional law, Administrative law, Company law, Law of Contract, Environmental law, IPR and Jurisprudence.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will have to write an essay on a current legal topic which shall carry 30 marks. Students will have to write the essay within the space provided in the booklet. No extra sheet shall be provided to the candidates. Viva – voce will contain 20 marks. The admission committee thereafter will prepare a merit list of provisionally selected candidates which shall be displayed in the university notice board and website.
<p align="center">PhD(Artificial Intelligence/Bioinformatics/Data Mining/DNA Computing)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Applicants shortlisted must appear in ARGUCOM Research Test (ART) Exemptions to ART are allowed on any of the criteria below: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Applicants with UGC-NET (including valid score of JRF/UGC-CSIRNET/SLET/GATE/teacher fellowship) M. Phil degree holders from State Govt. /Central Govt. Universities. Candidates declared to have cleared ART and those exempted would have to appear for a presentation followed by a viva-voce on a topic the candidate is desirous of pursuing his/her research work. <p>ARGUCOM Research Test (ART): ARGUCOM Research Test (ART) consists of questions of a total 100 marks. The duration of the test is 3 hours. ART would include Objective type, short answer type and descriptive type questions. The questions should be formulated to obtain an idea of the candidate's aptitude towards research.</p>

➤ **How to apply:**

- Eligible candidates seeking admission into programmes other than PhD at ARGUCOM are required to fill up the online application form and pay an application fee of Rs. 700/- (Rs. 350/- for ST/SC/PWD) via SBI collect (Link available on the website). PhD application fees is Rs.1000/- for all categories.
- No printed application form will be issued separately.
- Application fees are not refundable.
- It is to be noted that a duly filled-in application form through online submission is mandatory for all candidates.
- Candidates are advised to go through the details carefully before filling in the online application form.
- Candidates are also requested to maintain a valid e-mail account and contact number throughout the selection process.
- Candidates appearing in final year examinations may also apply. On selection, they should submit their final year mark sheet on or before 30th November, 2023. If any candidate fails to submit the same, their candidature will be cancelled.
- The last date for online Application forms is the **30th of July, 2023.**

➤ **Scholarship to students under three (3) categories:**

In order to contribute to the policy of inclusiveness and access to education, the University proposes to establish scholarship schemes under three (3) categories;

1. To PWD, ST-SC, and BPL students enrolled in the various Master's Programmes w.e.f. semester commencing academic year 2023-24 as 35% waiver in the tuition fees component of the respective academic programmes.
2. To students engaged in Sports (National level awardee), enrolled in the various Master's Programmes w.e.f. semester commencing academic year 2023-24 as 50% waiver in the tuition fees component of the respective academic programmes.

3. To students engaged in Cultural activity (National level awardee or equivalent awardee in activities/competitions conducted by National level organizations), irrespective of caste & creed, enrolled in the various Master's programmes w.e.f. semester commencing the academic year 2023-24 as 50% waiver in the tuition fees component of the respective academic programmes.

The selection/equivalence criteria for point no. 2 & 3 will be evaluated by the Selection Committee as decided by the University from time to time
